A BRIEF HISTORY OF SCOTCH WHISKY

1494

The earliest documented record of distilling in Scotland. An entry in the Exchequer Rolls list 'Eight bolls of malt to Friar John Cor wherewith to make aqua vitae'.

1644

The first official taxes on Scotch Whisky production are imposed, causing a rise in illicit whisky distilling across Scotland.

1785

Scotland's bard, Robert Burns, writes the poem 'Scotch Drink' which includes the line 'O thou, my muse! guid auld Scotch drink!'

1831

Aeneas Coffey invents the Patent Still. This led to the production of lighter flavoured Grain Whisky which, when blended with more fiery malts, extended the appeal of Scotch Whisky.

1880

The phylloxera beetle devastates French vineyards. Scots are quick to take advantage and Scotch Whisky replaced brandy as the spirit of choice.

1920

Prohibition begins in the United States of America. The federal government made an exemption for whisky prescribed by a doctor for medicinal purposes.

1939

World War II reshaped the industry's history. One cabinet minister said, the country needs food, dollars mean food, and whisky means dollars. Annual export targets were agreed and producers increasingly looked to overseas markets.

1994

The 500th anniversary of whisky production in Scotland. Exports of Scotch Whisky reach £2 billion for the first time in history.

2018

Scotch Whisky is the world's undisputed premier whisky. 39 bottles of Scotch are shipped from Scotland every second to nearly 200 markets around the globe.

The peat is present and quite pungent with an earthen rootiness. The finish is long and crisp

MORTLACH 25 YRS 100.00

25 years, 43.4%, Speyside, Est 1823

The best of the best, a full, rich palate with malt & muted spices interplaying between sweet and savoury elements

OLD PULTENEY 7.60

12 years, 40%, Highlands, Est 1826

Dry, medium bodied and smooth with a clean finish; faintly salty with a slight sherry note

BALVENIE DOUBLE WOOD 7.60

10 years, 40%, Speyside, Est 1893

Barrelled in both whisky & sherry oak, acquiring rich mellow flavour of great depth and complexity

DALMORE 9.20

12 years, 40%, Highlands, Est 1839

This single malt is a toasty, coffee rich dram with beautifully spiced notes, very rich for a 12 year old

GLENFARCLAS 10.50

15 years, 46%, Speyside, Est 1836

Intense and fruity with tastes of honey and fudge, more like a celebration cake than whisky, simply astonishing

GLENGOYNE 7.20

10 years, 40%, Lowlands, Est 1833

Smooth & delicate on the palate with with sweet aromas of malt, oak, and a hint of sherry

GLENMORANGIE 7.60

10 years, 40%, Highlands, est 1843

Classic malt, thick and fruity with notes of oranges whilst being fresh and balanced

ISLE OF JURA 7.20

10 years, 40%, Jura, Est 1810

Enjoys fruity undertones, with a hint of island smoke and salt air, to enrich the palette

Tequila was first produced in the 16th century near the location of the city of Tequila, which was not officially established until 1666. The Aztec people had previously made a fermented beverage from the agave plant, long before the Spanish arrived in 1521. When the Spanish conquistadors ran out of their own brandy, they began to distill agave to produce one of North America's first indigenous distilled spirits. Mexican laws state that tequila can only be produced in the state of Jalisco.

In addition, Armagnac for the most part was made and sold by small producers, mostly family owned distillers, whereas Cognac production is dominated by big-name brands.

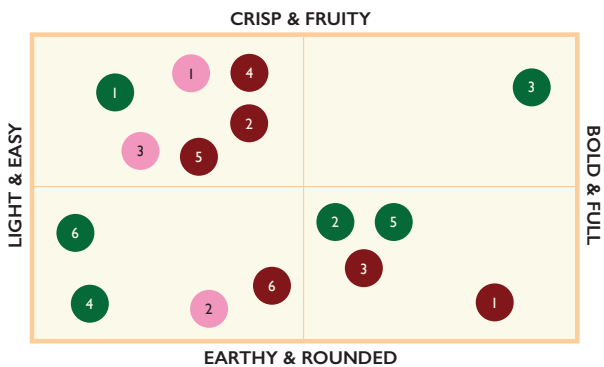
